One night in 2001, in the audience of a punk show at the now defunct Minneapolis health food/punk rock club Bon Appetit, guitarists Tim Uhl and Jon Greenlee officially decided to seek out a drummer and bass player to advance on the success of their recent home recording projects. Space Camp was born. With the addition of heavy fisted drummer Aaron Seevers and bassist Adam Meyers, Space Camp cast its drowning gaze on pop and surfaced with glorious epic rock swirling back down the rusty drain.

This defined the sound of their sold-out debut LP "If You Find The Old Beat, Play It". Now, over 2 years later, and concurrent with the launch of its namesake label, the long awaited masterpiece and painstakingly built patchwork of regret and brutality, "Royalty, Etc.", awakens April 15th. Minneapolis producer Mike Wisti returns and conjures layer after layer of magic from groaning classic gear, analog tape, and fritzing tubes over this 14-track classic (15 tracks on the download-only exclusive version w/ bonus cut)

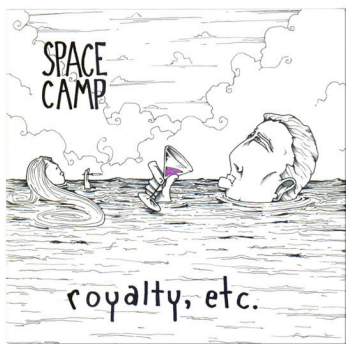
